

Elkford Skating Club Communicable Disease Policy - September 9th, 2021

Elkford Skating Club will be following all public health orders set forth by the BC government and local health authority. For example: mandated mask wearing, social distancing, and contact tracing when necessary.

If you are sick please do not come to any skating events. This includes Covid and non-Covid-like symptoms.

If you do come to skating sick, you will be asked to leave and will not be permitted to skate.

In the event that there is an outbreak within the skating club, the club executive will:

- Ensure that appropriate notifications are made to those affected.
- Make sure that there is effective communication to maintain the health and safety of all members.
- Follow all public health recommendations for operating and or suspending programs until the outbreak is deemed over.

We ask that all families make a commitment to keeping our club safe by following all of the provincial and local guidelines.

We also ask all families to please notify the club executive with any knowledge of possible exposures to illness within our programs. This will ensure efficient tracing is completed and lower the risk to other club members.
